# Subject + be + GOING TO + VERB + complement

- Chuco isn't going to eat tacos tomorrow
- ? Is chucho going to eat tacos tomorrow?
- +Yes, he is. no, he isn't
- + you are going to CLEAN your room this weekend
- you aren't going to CLEAN Your room this weekend.
- ? Are you going to clean your room this weekend?
- +yes, I am. -no, I'm not

# **SUBJECT + HAS /HAVE + PARTICIPLE VERB + COMPLEMENT**

Have: I, you, we, they has: he,she,it

Have not / haven't has not /hasn't

Contracción: Have: 've has: 's / I've traveled... she's traveled

# Examples:

+ Damaris has failed Geography 2 times.

- Damaris hasn't failed Geography .....

y/n? Has Damaris failed Geography ...?

+ yes, she has - no, she hasn't

Angel and his sister have been to Ocotepec.

Angel and his sister haven't been to Ocotepec.

Have angel and his sister been to Ocotepec?

+yes, they have - no they haven't
