Nice / nicer This phone **is nicer than** your phone.

Big / bigger My house **is bigger than** my friend's house.

Funny / funnier Adam Sandler's movies **are funnier than** Omar Chaparro's movies.

Nice / the nicest This phone **is the nicest** in the market

Big / the biggest My house **is the biggest** in the neighborhood.

Funny / the funniest Adam Sandler's movies **are the funniest** of Hollywood.

**BE GOING TO :** Lo usamos para decir : VOY A..

Be going to : Be=Is / are/ am

**Subject + be + GOING TO + VERB + complement**

Example :

+Chucho is going to EAT tacos tomorrow

- Chuco isn't going to eat tacos tomorrow

? Is chucho going to eat tacos tomorrow ?

+Yes, he is. - no, he isn't

+ you are going to CLEAN your room this weekend

- you aren't going to CLEAN Your room this weekend.

? Are you going to clean your room this weekend ?

+yes, I am. -no, I'm not

## UNIDAD 11

### PRESENT PERFECT.

#### SUBJECT + HAS /HAVE + PARTICIPLE VERB + COMPLEMENT

Have : I, you, we, they has: he, she, it

Have not / haven't has not / hasn't

Contracción :Have: 've has: 's / I've traveled... she's traveled

Examples:

+ Damaris has failed Geography 2 times.

- Damaris hasn't failed Geography .....

y/n ? Has Damaris failed Geography ...?

+ yes, she has - no, she hasn't

Angel and his sister have been to Ocotepc.

Angel and his sister haven't been to Ocotepc.

Have angel and his sister been to Ocotepc ?

+yes, they have - no they haven't

## HAVE YOU EVER \_\_\_\_\_?

**HAS:** he, she, it

has not / hasn't

's

**HAVE:** I, you, they, we

have not / haven't

've

(+) **SUBJECT + HAVE/HAS + PARTICIPLE VERB + COMPLEMENT**

(-) **SUBJECT + HAVEN'T / HASN'T + PARTICIPLE VERB + COMPLEMENT**

(?) **HAVE/HAS + SUBJECT + PARTICIPLE VERB + COMPLEMENT ?**

HAVE YOU EVER \_\_\_\_\_?

**Have** you ever **drunk** chilate? sad

NO, I HAVEN'T

YES, I HAVE. I **drank** chilate last year.

**Have** you ever **written** a love letter?

Yes, I have. I **wrote** it 4 years ago.

**Have** you ever **broken** a window?

Yes, I have. I **broke** it when I **was** in primary school.

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## UNIDAD 12. Revision de los 5 tiempos gramaticales.

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### TENSE REVIEW

**SIMPLE PRESENT:** Daily routine, habits. **time expressions:** always, sometimes, twice a week, every day.

3<sup>rd</sup> person, he, she, it : "s" – "es"                      do /does    don't / doesn't

- Antonio **does** exercise every day.
- Antonio and his father **do** exercise every day.

**PRESENT PROGRESSIVE:** action in the moment. **time expressions:** right now, now, at the moment

Be + ing verb

- Antonio **is doing** exercise now.
- Antonio and his father **are doing** exercise now.

**FUTURE WITH BE GOING TO:** plans for a near future. **time expressions:** tomorrow, next week, next month, tonight.

**Be + going to + verb**

- Antonio **is going to do exercise** tonight.
- Antonio and his father **are going to do exercise** tonight.

**SIMPLE PAST:** something in the past started and finished. **time expressions:** yesterday, 2 months ago, last week.

Regular / irregular verbs    watch- watched    do-did

- Antonio **did** exercise yesterday.
- Antonio and his father **did** exercise yesterday.

**PRESENT PERFECT:** action done many times/experiences/ action that started in the past and may continue in the present. **time expressions:** ever / since / for.

Have /has    've / 's    haven't/ hasn't    +    participle verb

- Antonio **has done** exercise many times.
- Antonio and his father **have done** exercise many times.
